For Beginning Band, your child will need an instrument, an inexpensive wire music stand, and the "Sound Innovations" Book One. Percussionists also need the "Alfred Snare Drum Method" Book One.

We use Quinlan and Fabish for all our music instruments, supplies, and repairs. We have worked with them for many years and they supply us with quality instruments and service. Their rep delivers to our school every week.

You can visit the store or call. Tell them you are with Center Cass District 66, Mr. Ohlsen director. ALL the instruments and supplies I have specified will come up.

I have specified the following extra supplies for each: (Hopefully, I haven't forgotten anything...)

Flute: Nothing extra, though you may consider a cleaning swab.

Oboe: Silk cleaning swab (so it doesn't get stuck), and a soft cane reed to go with the plastic one supplied.

Clarinet: Cork grease, handkerchief swab, reed holder, one box Juno 2 ½ clarinet reeds.

Alto Sax: Cork grease, cleaning swab, reed holder, one box Juno 2 ½ alto sax reeds, padded neck strap.

Trumpet: Cleaning snake and mouthpiece brush.

French Horn: Nothing extra.

Trombone: Cleaning snake and mouthpiece brush.

Baritone: Cleaning snake and mouthpiece brush.

Tuba: Helleberg Tuba mouthpiece, instrument stand (best found via Amazon)

Percussion: I've upgraded the bell mallets and drumsticks. The sticks are Vic Firth 5BN.

This should cover most anything you need to get going. If I've missed anything, or you have any questions, please email me.
