- The maximum scholarship award is \$100.00.
- Regular attendance and participation in in-school lessons, rehearsals and concerts is required for consideration.
- Students who are awarded summer music scholarships must provide highlights of their summer music experience with their director. These highlights will be promoted by the directors and music boosters.
- Student scholarship checks will be made payable to the music camp or private music teacher. Camps that have been paid in full will require proof of payment to receive reimbursement if a scholarship is awarded.
- Applications must be complete to be considered.
- Summer camp scholarships must be used prior to Sept. 1.
- Private instruction scholarships must be used within 6 months of the award.
